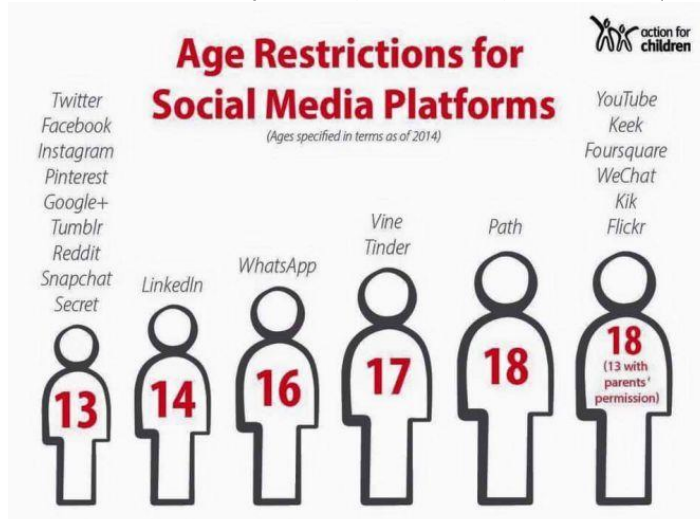
JUNIOR PARK RUN

CHILDREN IN NEED

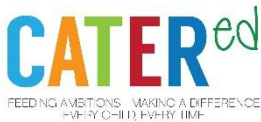
