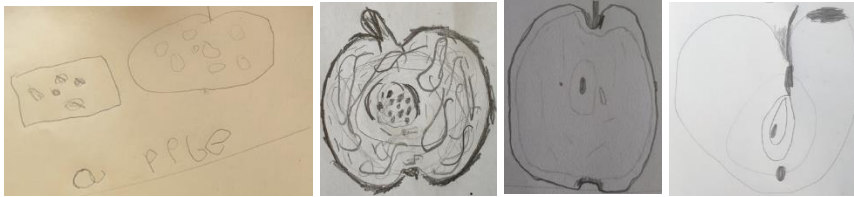
'Growing and Achieving Together'
