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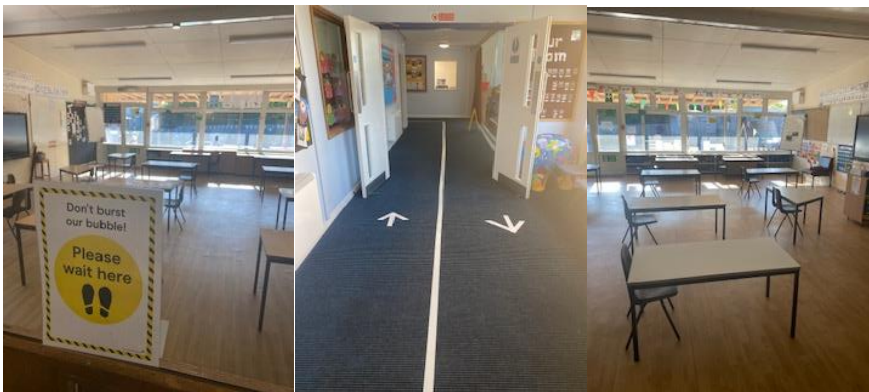

BACK TO SCHOOL

For Year 1 and Year 6, Monday 8th June is the start for children to phase back into school in their specified bubble groups. Many children (and parents) might be a little anxious about this so we have put together some information for you to share with your child prior to their return to school.

What it looks like...



Things I need to remember...

- Follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising.
- Follow the 'Show Me 5' rules in school.
- Follow the 'Remember 5' rules for COVID-19 safe practice.
- Stay in my bubble and not mix with any other children on site.
- Follow my teacher's instructions on where I am allowed to be in the building.
- Follow the expectations around sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal (Catch it, bin it, kill it).
- Tell an adult if I am feeling unwell or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- Follow rules about sharing equipment or other items.
- My own water bottle and packed lunch box but **no other items** are permitted into school (e.g. bags/pencil cases/teddies etc).
- Follow the staggered break and lunch time routine and understand that I will be eating and playing in different areas of the school.
- There will be no more than 3 children in the cloakroom/toilets at any one time.
- Not to pretend or actually spit or cough towards any other person - this may result in me not being allowed in school.
