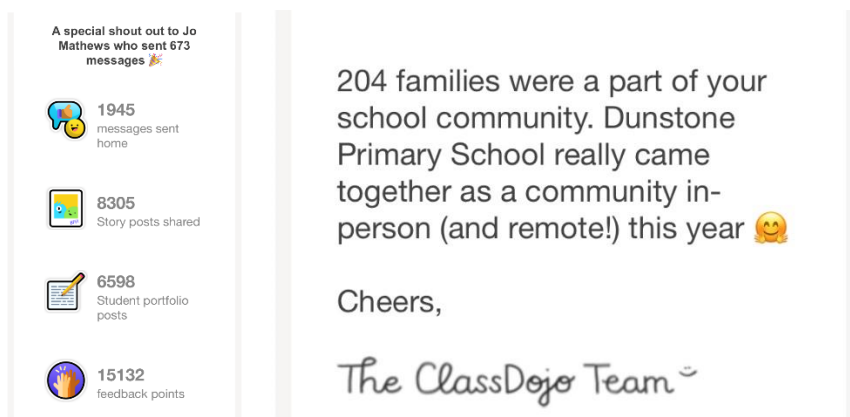

## EDUCARE

Educare provision is for those children of critical workers in the response of COVID 19, as a last resort where there is no other option for child care. This link will be active until **12:00 noon on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June**. You will then receive confirmation of your place. Additionally, it is for those children deemed vulnerable as a supportive measure. Those children who were invited by school will continue to have the agreed places on the days given. Please liaise with school staff regarding this provision.

## PHASE 2 REOPENING

Phase 1 of the partial reopening has proved to be successful and the children have thoroughly enjoyed being back with their friends and in school with staff. We are now planning phase 2 of the reopening which will hopefully see a further year group return to school on the WeST agreed date of 22<sup>nd</sup> June. To help with this planning process, if your child is in **foundation** (Willow) and you are **not intending** for them to return to school, please could you call the school office to inform us of your decision. Additionally, if your child is in **year 1** (Rowan) and you would like your child to **return** as part of **phase 2**, please could you inform the school office of your decision. More information will be shared once the plan has been finalised and risk assessments updated.
