Dear Parents and Carers,

## Reopening of Dunstone Primary on Tuesday 5th January

Happy New Year! I hope that you managed to enjoy a restful Christmas break with your family. As I am sure you are aware, the government released some key information on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> December, regarding the planned reopening of schools during the ongoing pandemic. The following key points are for your information:

1. The majority of primary schools in England will reopen as planned during the week commencing Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January – this applies to Dunstone Primary School. At this moment in time, only primary schools in tier 4 areas of concerning rates of infection will remain closed and move to remote learning provision from the beginning of term.

**To be clear, Dunstone Primary School will reopen as normal to all pupils on Tuesday 5th January as planned. Monday is a training day for staff and the school will be closed to pupils.**

2. Plymouth and Devon have now moved tier status from tier 2 to tier 3. A poster is attached to summarise the restrictions of tier 3. More information can be found on the gov.uk website.

Dunstone Primary School will continue to review and operate the range of additional control measures that we had in place last term, to ensure that we are doing all that we can to safeguard and protect our children and staff. I know that some parents may well be feeling worried about sending their children back to school, and please don't hesitate to contact me if you have any questions about next week.

As always, parents and families should continue to follow the 3 key protective measures:

- Hands – Wash your hands regularly, including before dropping your child off and after picking them up.
- Face – Wear a face covering at all times when on the school site.
- Space – Keep yourself and your children 2 metres from other families.

We are very much look forward to welcoming the children back to school on Tuesday.
